RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AMENDING RESOLUTION # 2004-02 SECTION 5, THAT ESTABLISHES ORDER OF BUSINESS IN ALL MEETINGS; RE-ESTABLISHING THAT THE CITIZEN PRESENTATIONS SHALL BE THE 9TH ORDER OF BUSINESS; ESTABLISHING THAT THE NUMBER SEQUENCE SHALL BE MAINTAINED FOR ALL SUBSEQUENT ITEMS OF THE AGENDA; THAT THE GOOD AND WELFARE SHALL BE CHANGED FOR THE GOOD OF THE ORDER; AND BY AMENDING ERRATAS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2004-02 establishes the Rules of the Table, adopted by the City Commission on January 7, 2004; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Citizen's presentations should be heard by the City Commission at an earlier time in the agenda; and

WHEREAS, it has further been determined that the good of the order is a better description than good and welfare; and

WHEREAS, certain typographical errors have been detected that should be corrected by interlineation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5 of Resolution 2004-02 shall be amended to have the Citizen's presentations as the 9th order of business of all agendas.


SECTION 2. That the number system for the rest of the agenda items shall be maintained in the agenda.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature of the Mayor.




