RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PIGGY BACK OFF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD CONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH IPS GROUP PARKING AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS IN LIEU OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI COMPETITIVE PROCEDURE; ACCEPTING A COMPETITIVE BID WHICH HAS BEEN SECURED ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING PARKING METERS AS PART OF THE CITY'S PARKING METER PROGRAM AND ONGOING MAINTENANCE FOR A CAP OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) TO BE FUNDED 100% FROM SURTAX/PTP, CONSISTING OF TWENTY (20) METERS , PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF METERS, PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of West Miami, Florida desire to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying proposal; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami has engaged in researching vendors for a specific type of parking meter and has secured a pricing from local companies; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami found that vendor, IPS Group Parking And Telecommunications underwent procurement procedures in the City of Hollywood; and

WHEREAS, the parking meters purchased by the City of Hollywood are similar to the unique needs of the City of West Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood parking meter requirements are similar to the needs of the City of West Miami; and

WHEREAS, City Administration, after thorough investigation and research, has found that the product offered by IPS Group Parking And Telecommunications is the adequate product for the City of West Miami; and

WHEREAS, the proposal for the purchase of twenty(20) parking meters and ongoing maintenance for a cap of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) has been found to be acceptable; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Public Works Director have recommended the acceptance of the above referenced proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

SECTION 1. The aforementioned statements are true and correct and adopted as is fully stated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager the expenditure of a cap of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) in connection with the purchase and ongoing maintenance of twenty (20) parking meters as part of the City of West Miami Parking Program.

SECTION 3. The funds to further the purposes described in the funding request shall be paid from Surtax/PTP Funds.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature of the Mayor.




