



**RESOLUTION # 2016-72**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PAY THE SUM OF \$15,400.00 FOR ADDITIONAL WORK IN CONNECTION WITH THE RE-DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF SW 62 AVENUE MEDIAN TO ADAPT TO THE MIAMI DADE COUNTY STANDARDS WHICH EXCEEDED THE ORIGINAL SCOPE AND TIMELINE SCHEDULE, PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FOR THESE SERVICES TO BE FUNDED FROM THE PTP (1/2 CENT PENNY TAX PROCEEDS) FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup>, 2016 FROM ITS UNRESTRICTED AND UNDESIGNATED RESERVE BALANCE, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of West Miami, Florida desire to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the original proposal dated September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 for the amount of \$34,080.00 included Scope of Services for Construction Inspection Services, LAP Specialist and Project Coordinator considering a project duration of 6 months; and

**WHEREAS**, Due to design modification on S.W. 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, a County Road, suggested by MDC Public Works, and delays obtaining the permits for construction (one year), the number of hours for design modification, LAP Specialist to comply with FHWA LAP projects and inspection services increased considerably from the original budget of \$34,080.00 to \$49,480.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager and Public Works Director have recommended the acceptance of the above referenced proposal.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

SECTION 1. The aforementioned statements are true and correct and adopted as is fully stated herein.

SECTION 2. The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept the proposal of fifteen thousand four hundred dollars and zero cents (\$15,400.00) from T.Y. Lin International to provide engineering and construction management services for the LAP Traffic Calming Devices project.

SECTION 3. The funds to further the purposes described in the funding request shall be paid from PTP Funds.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature of the Mayor.
