



**RESOLUTION # 2021-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROPOSAL/CONTRACT WITH ONE WAY STRIPING, INC. IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$15,900.00 TO ACCOMPLISH DIRECTIVES BY MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS TO COMPLY WITH FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND TO CORRECT DEFICIENCIES WITHIN TRAFFIC CIRCLES AS MORE DESCRIBED IN A LETTER DATED JANUARY 22, 2021 BY THE TRANSFORMATION DIRECTOR ALICE BRAVO ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT A; THIS CONTRACT SHALL BE FUNDED BY ACCOUNT # 542-222; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami has been informed by the Transportation and Public Works Department of deficiencies in seven (7) traffic circles located within the City of West Miami as described in Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration has requested proposals to correct said deficiencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami received quotations from One Way Striping, Inc. and Maggolc Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, after review of quotations received hereinabove, the City Administration has found One Way Striping, Inc. to be the lowest, responsive responsible bidder, a copy of the quote is attached as Exhibit B; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager recommends award to One Way Striping, Inc. for the amount of Fifteen Thousand, Nine Hundred and no/100 (\$15,900.00) in order to accomplish the tasks outlined in Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

**Section 1.** The foregoing "whereas" clauses and heading are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

**Section 2.** The City Commission accepts the recommendation of the City Manager to award One Way Striping, Inc. with the contract to accomplish the directives of Miami-Dade Transportation and Public Works as described in Exhibit A.

**Section 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with One Way Striping, Inc. in the amount of Fifteen Thousand, Nine Hundred and no/100 (\$15,900.00).

Dear Ms. Aguilar:

The Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) communicated in early 2020 that there are 7 traffic circle locations within the City that do not comply with the Federal Highway Administration Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), and there may be design deficiencies as it relates to geometric deflection within the circles. The locations are:

1. SW 64 Ave @ SW 10 St
2. SW 64 Ave @ SW 12 St
3. SW 64 Ave @ SW 18 St
4. SW 64 Ave @ SW 22 St
5. SW 63 Ave @ SW 9 St
6. SW 64 Ave @ SW 11 St
7. SW 58 Ave @ SW 12 St

On February 3rd, 2020, the County requested the stop controls and signage to be removed and replaced with the corresponding yield signs and yield pavement markings. The County also request the approved County plans to verify the deflections. As of today, nothing has been done nor submitted.

In addition, the DTPW noticed that the City installed "residential parking only" signs throughout the City. While we understand that the City can manage the parking within the municipality to the effect that is on local residential streets without encroaching into the roadway and/or creating any operational impact; Article XIII section 2-97 gives Miami-Dade County jurisdiction over parking on major corridors.

**ARTICLE XIII. - TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

**Sec. 2-97. - Limitations on jurisdiction over parking, parking meters**

*"The Department shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the installation, location and regulation of parking meters and parking within the boundaries of any municipality only in respect to public roads designated as arterial streets"*

DTPW is requesting a meeting within the next 7-10 days to come to a resolution of the items mentioned above.
