A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI RELATED TO PROCUREMENT, SELECTING AND APPROVING THE EXPENSE TO V & G CONSTRUCTION SOLUTIONS, CORP. PIGGY-BACKING VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY'S ITB# 2023-11-002 "VILLAGE-WIDE TRAFFIC CALMING INSTALLATION DEVICES" IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FISCAL YEAR BUDGET 2023-2024 ALLOCATED FOR THE CITY'S TRAFFIC CALMING INITIATIVE IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$ 150,000.00) AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during the budget workshops, the City allocated an amount of \$ 150,000.00 towards the safe streets initiative to deter the speeding on residential streets and reduce outside vehicular traffic making the City safer to commute; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to adopt the Village of Palmetto Bay's recent traffic calming procurement process and implement it; and

WHEREAS, the determination of traffic calming devices shall be derived by a traffic study and a review of requests by concerned citizens; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2: The City Commission hereby accepts the adoption of the Village of Palmetto Bay's contract piggy-backing ITB# 2023-11-002 "Village-Wide Traffic Calming Installation Devices" and expenditure of \$ 150,000.00 allocated in fiscal year 2023-2024 of the adopted budget to V & G Construction Solutions, Corp,

Section 3: The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign a contract with V & G Construction Solutions, Corp.

Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
