RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION AMENDING RESOLUTION # 2019-05, BY REMOVING THE BANK SIGNATURE OF YOLANDA AGUILAR, CITY MANAGER WHO HAS RESIGNED EFFECTIVE MAY 29TH, 2023 AT MIDNIGHT AND ADDING THE SIGNATURE OF EDWARD SILVA CITY MANAGER WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF MAY 17TH, 2023, AND ADDING THE NAME AND SIGNATURE OF ILIANA ADAY, ACCOUNTING CLERK, PROVIDING A MAY 17TH, 2023 EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager, Yolanda Aguilar, has presented her resignation effective May 29th, 2023, and

WHEREAS, one of the City Managers duties is to have signatory powers at a bank used for city business, and

WHEREAS, as a result of Yolanda Aguilar's resignation, the new City Manager, Edward Silva, shall be added as a signor at the bank effective May 17th, 2023, and

WHEREAS, in addition, Iliana Aday, accounting clerk for the City of West Miami, shall also be added as a signor to any bank used for city business effective May 17th, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Commission approve and authorize the removal of the bank signature of Yolanda Aguilar and adding the signatures of incoming City Manager, Edward Silva and Accounting Clerk, Iliana Aday effective May 17th, 2023.

Section 3. Execution of the Agreement. Yolanda Aguilar as present Manager of the City is hereby authorized to execute the agreement attached hereto.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect on May 17th, 2023.
