



RESOLUTION # 2023-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, INSTRUCTING THE CITY ENGINEER TO CONDUCT A TRAFFIC STUDY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ABANDONING A RIGHT-OF-WAY EAST OF COOPER PARK, SPECIFICALLY, A ROAD LOCATED BETWEEN SW 15TH STREET AND SW 16TH STREET AND ON SW 57TH COURT; PROVIDING FOR THE REVERSAL OF TITLE TO ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNERS; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL OF INTENT TO MIAMI DADE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of West Miami believes it to be advantageous to conduct a traffic study for the closure of road located between SW 15th Street and SW 16th ST and on SW 57th Court; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer shall conduct a traffic study in order to effectuate said road closure; and

WHEREAS, the title to the abandoned road shall be reversed to the adjacent property owners; and

WHEREAS, the Right-of-Way shall be dedicated and added to Cooper Park and its use shall be determined by the Parks Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2. The City Engineer is instructed to perform a traffic study for the purpose of abandoning a Right-Of-Way East of Cooper Park, specifically, a road located between SW 15th Street Street and SW 16th Street and on SW 57th Court.

Section 3. The City Clerk is instructed to disseminate the City's intent to close road to Miami-Dade County after the conclusion of the traffic study.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature by the Mayor.


