



RESOLUTION # 2023-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF THREE POLICE ADMINISTRATIVE VEHICLES FROM GERBER FORD, TO REPLACE OBSOLETE UNITS, UNDER THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FROM FLORIDA'S SHERIFF BID IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$159,439.00); FUNDING WILL NOT IMPACT THE CITY'S GENERAL FUNDS; FUNDING SHALL COME FROM FORFEITED AND SEIZED PROPERTIES IN CRIMINAL FEDERAL CASES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami recognizes the need to replace the currently obsolete police administrative vehicles to ensure the effective functioning of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified Gerber Ford, Inc. as the vendor providing the necessary vehicles under the Cooperative Purchasing Program from Florida's Sheriff Bid; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the purchase is One Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$159,439.00); and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the funding for the purchase will not impact the City's General Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the funding for the purchase will not impact the City's General Funds but will be sourced from forfeited and seized properties in criminal federal cases; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commissioners have thoroughly reviewed the proposed purchase and find it to be in the best interest of the City of West Miami and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2. The purchase of three police administrative vehicles from Gerber Ford, Inc. under the Cooperative Purchasing Program from Florida's Sheriff Bid, in the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$159,439.00), is hereby approved.

Section 3. The funding for the purchase of the aforementioned vehicles shall not impact the City's General Funds and shall be sourced from forfeited and seized properties in criminal federal cases.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature by the Mayor.
