



RESOLUTION # 2023-52

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, INSTRUCTING THE CITY MANAGER TO RE-ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (REP) FOR RE-STRIPING AND REFINISHING THE CITY'S TENNIS COURT, ADDING PICKLEBALL STRIPING; OBTAINING QUOTATIONS FOR A NEW LIGHTING SYSTEM FOR SAID FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami recognizes the importance of maintaining and improving its recreational facilities for the benefit of residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City's tennis court is in need of re-striping and refinishing to ensure proper functionality and safety; and

WHEREAS, there is an increasing demand for pickleball in the community, and adding pickleball stepping to the tennis court would enhance recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to explore the possibility of installing a new lighting system for the tennis court to extend its usability into evening hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing "whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby instructed to re-issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) seeking proposals from qualified vendors for the re-striping and refinishing of the City's tennis court, including the addition of pickleball stepping.

Section 3. The RFP shall outline the necessary specifications, requirements, and guidelines for the project, including the addition of pickleball stepping. Vendors submitting proposals must meet the qualifications specified in the RFP.

Section 4. The City Manager shall also obtain quotations for the installation of a new lighting system for the tennis court, allowing for extended use during evening hours. The quotations shall be presented to the City Commission for review and consideration.

Section 5. The City Manager, in consultation with relevant city departments and stakeholders, shall evaluate the received proposals and lighting system quotations based on criteria such as experience, cost, quality, and overall suitability for the project. Following the evaluation process, the City Manager shall present the recommended vendor(s) and lighting system quotation(s) to the City Commission for approval.

Section 6. The necessary funds for the re-striping, refinishing, addition of pickleball stepping, and installation of the new lighting system shall be allocated from the appropriate budgetary resources. The City Manager is authorized to take any necessary steps to secure the funding and ensure its availability for the project.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature by the Mayor.
