A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA; RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CHILDREN'S TRUST COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT & COMMUNITY OUTREACH GRANTS PROGRAM FOR DIRECT SERVICES TO IMPLEMENT A SIX (6) WEEK STEM PROGRAM DURING THE 2025 WEST MIAMI RECREATION CENTER SUMMER CAMP SESSION FOR STUDENT ENTERING 6TH TO 8TH GRADE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami recognizes the importance of providing educational and enrichment opportunities for its youth; and

WHEREAS, the Children's Trust offers grant funding to support programs that enhance the development and well-being of children and youth; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami seeks to implement a six-week STEM Summer Program to engage middle school youth in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) activities, fostering their interest and skills in these critical areas; and

WHEREAS, the proposed STEM Summer Program will provide a structured and supportive environment for children during the six-week session, promoting learning, creativity, and social interaction; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that applying for the Children's Trust Community Engagement & Community Outreach grants program is in the best interest of the community and its youth.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

THE ABOVE WHEREAS' ARE ADOPTED HEREIN AS PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.

Section 1: The City Commission hereby retroactively authorizes the submission of a grant application to The Children's Trust Community Engagement & Community Outreach Grant Program for the implementation of a six-week STEM Summer Program.

Section 2: The City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents and take all necessary actions in connection with the submission of the grant application.

Section 3: The resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
