



**RESOLUTION # 2024-44**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA; RELATING TO GRANTS; APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AND EXPRESS COMPANIES, INC. FROM THE CORPORATE BUY-DOWN SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM; ACCEPTING THE GRANT AMOUNT OF ELEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (\$11,288.20) TO PURCHASE TWENTY (20) AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE THE TWENTY (20) AEDS FOR THE CITY AND OTHER RELATED DOCUMENTS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami recognizes the importance of maintaining effective and accessible emergency medical equipment to ensure the safety and well-being of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the Automated External Defibrillator (AEDs) is necessary for the continued safety and health of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** The purchase of Twenty (20) Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) from Express Companies, Inc. is hereby approved.

**Section 2:** The total purchase amount for the AEDs will be Twenty Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-one Dollars and Eighty cents (\$20,391.80); after AED Grant and FMIT Safety Grant, the City cost share will be Seventeen Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-one Dollars and Eighty cents (\$17,391.80).

**Section 3:** Funding for this purchase shall come from General Funds.

**Section 4:** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
