



## RESOLUTION # 2024-61

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA; RELATING TO GRANTS; AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION TO THE T-MOBILE HOMETOWN GRANT PROGRAM, TO REQUEST THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY-THOUSAND (\$50,000) DOLLARS, TO PURCHASE TWO (2) DIGITAL, INFORMATIONAL KIOSKS TO BE PLACED AT HIGH TRAFFIC LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY TO CREATE AN ADDITIONAL PLATFORM TO KEEP THE PUBLIC INFORMED OF CITY EVENTS, MEETINGS AND INCREASE ENGAGEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City of West Miami to improve the way we provide information to our residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami is experiencing a need for increased forms of informing our residents of events, meetings, and activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is preparing an application from the T-Mobile Hometown Grant Program in coordination with the Cornerstone Kiosks' Beautification and Placemaking branding program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to include the project named in the T-Mobile Hometown Grant Program application as "Let's Stay Connected – Community Initiative" in its Capital Improvement Plan for FY 2023-2024.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

**THE ABOVE WHEREAS' ARE ADOPTED HEREIN AS PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.**

**Section 1:** The City of West Miami hereby commits to implementing the improvements specified on its grant application provided that the funding request of \$50,000 is approved.

**Section 2:** The City of West Miami hereby includes the "Let's Stay Connected – Community Initiative" project as identified in the grant application in its Capital Improvement Plan for FY 2023-2024.

**Section 3:** The resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.

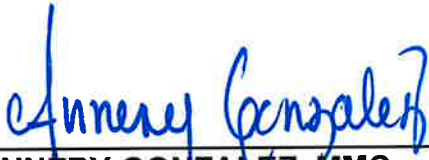
