



RESOLUTION # 2024-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT TO RENEW THE RED-LIGHT CAMERA CONTRACT WITH RED SPEED FLORIDA LLC, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City of West Miami’s contract with Vera Mobility expires September 30th 2024; and

WHEREAS, Vera provided the support of the Red-Light Camera program since its inception in 2009; and

WHEREAS, The City of West Miami has exercised all contractual extensions with Vera Mobility to date; and

WHEREAS, REDSPEED LLC, will provide support of the Red Light Camera Program as well as the School Zone Speed cameras under one contract; and

WHEREAS, REDSPEED has the exclusive knowledge, possession, and ownership of certain equipment, licenses, and processes for automated enforcement of School Zone Speed (“SPE”) and Red-Light enforcement (“Traffic Safety Cameras”), collectively referred to herein as “The Systems”; and

WHEREAS, City of West Miami desires to use The Systems to monitor and enforce both red light violations and school zone speed; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 1, 2023, the Governor of the State of Florida signed HB 657 into law, resulting in Laws of Florida 2023-174; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of Florida 2023-174 expressly authorizes municipalities to use traffic infraction detectors to enforce certain provisions of Chapter 316 of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Mark Wandall Safety Act authorizes automated enforcement of Red-Light Violations;


