



RESOLUTION # 2024-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A VOLUNTARY MUTUAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AND THE CITY OF HIALEAH FOR THE EXCHANGE AND COLLABORATION OF SOCIAL, CULTURAL, AND ARTISTIC PIECES, TRADITIONS, AND IDEAS; ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF THE SCULPTURE “HIALEAH BEAT” FROM THE CITY OF HIALEAH; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami and the City of Hialeah desire to collaborate on the exchange of social, cultural, and artistic pieces, traditions, and ideas; and

WHEREAS, as part of this collaboration, the City of Hialeah has offered to donate the sculpture “Hialeah Beat,” created by Cuban-American artist Pedro Hernandez, to the City of West Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami wishes to accept this donation and showcase the sculpture for the enjoyment of residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that this collaboration and the donation of the sculpture are in the best interest of the City of West Miami and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement between the City of West Miami and the City of Hialeah as attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION 3: The Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the donation of the sculpture “Hialeah Beat” from the City of Hialeah.

SECTION 4: The City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the City of Hialeah.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


