



**RESOLUTION # 2024-92**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA; RELATING TO ART IN PUBLIC PLACES (AIPP); ACCEPTING AN ART SCULPTURE TO BE RELOCATED FROM OUR SISTER CITY OF HIALEAH TO WEST MIAMI; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RELOCATE THE SCULPTURE FROM THE CITY OF HIALEAH; APPROVING THE SCULPTURE TO BE INSTALLED AT THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE ON SW 62<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE AND SW 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET NEAR THE WEST MIAMI RECREATION CENTER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami is committed to enhancing public spaces through the Art in Public Places (AIPP) program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah, our sister city, has generously offered to donate an art sculpture to the City of West Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami wishes to accept this donation and relocate the sculpture to a prominent location within the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami recognizes the importance of maintaining aesthetic standards for public art and requires that the Art Advisory Board approve the colors and location of the sculpture prior to installation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission approves the proposed location for the sculpture is the traffic circle at SW 62nd Avenue and SW 18th Street, outside of the West Miami Recreation Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager is authorized to oversee the relocation and installation of the sculpture from the City of Hialeah to the designated location in West Miami.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

**THE ABOVE WHEREAS' ARE ADOPTED HEREIN AS PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.**

**Section 1:** The City of West Miami hereby accepts the donation of the art sculpture from the City of Hialeah.

**Section 2:** The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to take all necessary actions to relocate and install the sculpture at the approved traffic circle on SW 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and SW 18<sup>th</sup> Street, outside of the West Miami Recreation Center.

**Section 3:** The approval of the final colors and the exact location for the sculpture installation shall be subject to the review and approval of the Art Advisory Board.

**Section 4:** The resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
