**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI DADE COUNTY MUNICIPAL PARKING FINES REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM 2024 FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING ANY FUNDS AVAILABLE TO THE CITY FOR REIMBURSEMENT, PROGRAM FUNDS TO BE USED TO IMPROVE ACCESSIBILITY AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO QUALIFIED PHYSICALLY DISABLED PERSONS AND TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO CONDUCT PUBLIC AWARENESS PROGRAMS CONCERNING PHYSICALLY DISABLED PERSONS, PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City participated in the Municipal Parking Fines Reimbursement Program Affidavit in 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of West Miami have been notified that once again, the combination of fines collected in the previous fiscal year and unspent funds from other municipalities will enable our City to re-apply for funds through the application process for ADA related projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The aforementioned statements are true and correct and adopted as is fully stated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Municipal Parking Fines Reimbursement Program Affidavit attached herein as Exhibit A and submit request for funding for ADA related projects pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement between the City of West Miami and Miami-Dade County.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Commission and signature of the Mayor.
