



RESOLUTION # 2025-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, RELATING TO GRANTS, SPECIFICALLY THE 2024 VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT STUDY TO PROVIDE A DETAILED EXPOSURE AND SENSITIVITY ANALYSIS TO ASSESS THE CITY'S SUSCEPTIBILITY AND RISK TO DIFFERENT FLOODING SCENARIOS; ACCEPTING THE FINAL REPORT WITH PRESENTATION, FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REPORT FINDINGS FOLLOWING IDENTIFICATION AND AVAILABILITY OF APPROPRIATE FUNDING SOURCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami's entered into a Standard Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) on September 6, 2023 via Resolution #2023-73, for the development of a City-Wide Vulnerability Assessment study; and

WHEREAS, in response to the City's needs, a solicitation was advertised as RFP #2024-20-002 ON February 21, 2024; and

WHEREAS, this solicitation resulted in the selection of APTIM Environmental Infrastructure, LLC who completed the required elements as stated by the FDEP; and

WHEREAS, the study was performed by gathering background data, conducting exposure and analysis scenarios, and holding meetings with staff and the public to help determine results and develop proposed projects; and

WHEREAS, the result of the study culminated in a detailed Final Report for the City and an FDEP template summation to be presented in final form before our governing board; and

WHEREAS, the Administration requests that the City Commission accepts the Vulnerability Assessment Report by APTIM Environmental and further authorizes the City Manager to take all action necessary to implement recommendations on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

THE ABOVE WHEREAS' ARE ADOPTED HEREIN AS PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.

Section 1: The City Commission hereby accepts the final West Miami Vulnerability Assessment Plan prepared and presented by APTIM Environmental.

Section 2: The City Manager shall take all action necessary to identify relevant grants and coordinate in order to return to the City Commission with recommendations for the Commission to take further actions.

Section 3: The resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


