**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, RELATING TO THE USE OF GREEN SPACE FOR RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS; AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE JOINT USE AGREEMENT (JUA) WITH THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE USE OF DESIGNATED PORTION(S) OF SYLVANIA HEIGHTS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL'S CAMPUS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the use of green space for recreational programs, activities, and facilities

**WHEREAS**, green spaces provide critical opportunities for children and families to engage in physical activity, outdoor learning, and social interaction; and

**WHEREAS**, collaboration between the City and the School Board of Miami-Dade County and Sylvania Heights Elementary School can maximize the availability and use of green spaces to benefit children and families; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

**Section 1:** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

**Section 2:** Sylvania Heights Elementary School, located at 5901 SW 16 Street, West Miami, Florida, also described as Folio # 15-4012-013-0010, will be used by the City of West Miami for recreational and educational purposes.

**Section 3:** The School of Board of Miami-Dade County and the City of West Miami will enter into this Agreement to allow designated portion(s) of Sylvania Heights Elementary School campus for the use of City of West Miami recreational programs.

**Section 4:** This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
