RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI SUPPORTING GOVERNOR RON DESANTIS' EFFORTS IN IDENTIFYING UNNECESSARY SPENDING, CREATING EFFICIENCIES AND SAVING TAXPAYER DOLLARS. (Sponsored by Mayor Eric Diaz-Padron)

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2025, Governor DeSantis signed Executive Order 25-44, Ensuring Government Efficiency;

WHEREAS, the Executive Order establishes within the Office of Policy and Budget in the Executive Office of the Governor a Department of Governmental Efficiency Team ("EOG DOGE Team");

WHEREAS, the EOG DOGE Team is tasked in assisting local governments in helping identify unnecessary spending, eliminating waste, and saving taxpayers money; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami recognizes and applauds the efforts of Governor Ron DeSantis and the EOG DOGE Team to identify and eliminate unnecessary and inappropriate spending.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The above-stated "whereas" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2. The City of West Miami supports identifying and working to eliminate unnecessary spending, unnecessary programs, mis-aligned grants, and redundant contracts within the City, including those which may be inconsistent with the regulations of this State.

Section 3. The City of West Miami welcomes the efforts of Governor Ron DeSantis and will fully collaborate with the State of Florida's EOG DOGE Team.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission and signature by the Mayor.
