A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUPPORT AND APPROVE THE NAMING OF THAT PORTION BETWEEN SW 62ND AVENUE TO SW 59TH AVENUE ON SW 11TH STREET AS ALICIA DENIS AND MARGARITA DENIS STREET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Eric Diaz-Padron)

WHEREAS, Alicia and Margarita Denis are Cuban exiles who relocated to West Miami after initially going to New Jersey; and

WHEREAS Alicia and Margarita Denis lived at 6010 SW 11th Street for 34 years; and

WHEREAS Alicia and Margarita Denis are respected members of the community, known for their dedication to family, culture, and the betterment of those around them, inspiring not only their family but also the broader community;

WHEREAS, Alicia, his grandmother, and Margarita Denis, his aunt, helped raise Armando Christian Perez, known internationally as Pitbull,

WHEREAS, Alicia and Margarita Denis provided Armando Christian Perez with some of his best childhood memories in West Miami.

WHEREAS, the home that Alicia and Margarita Denis shared with Armando Christian Perez was fondly named his "Plan Z," a place where he knew he could always return regardless of any uncertainty in his life and would find comfort and safety.

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami desires to honor the legacy of Alicia Denis and Margarita Denis, the beloved grandmother and aunt of internationally renowned artist Pitbull.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission and signature by the Mayor.


