



RESOLUTION # 2025-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, REDUCING THE WATER CONSUMPTION PORTION OF THE UTILITY BILL FOR ITS RESIDENTS BY FOUR (4) PERCENT. (*Sponsored by Mayor Diaz-Padron*)

WHEREAS, due to price increases enacted by Miami-Dade County to the City, the City was forced to increase its utility billing to its residents this fiscal year which started October 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, after careful review, the City would like to reduce the portion of the water consumption bill by four (4) percent giving the residents some relief for the upcoming fiscal year which will start October 1, 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2: The reduction of four (4) percent on the water consumption portion of the utility bills will be part of the City’s budget for fiscal year 10/01/2025-09/30/2026.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.


