



## RESOLUTION #2025-46

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, REPEALING AND SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION #2025-31, AND REDUCING THE WATER CONSUMPTION FEE PORTION OF THE UTILITY BILL FOR ITS RESIDENTS BY SIX (6) PERCENT EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2025; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Diaz-Padron)**

**WHEREAS**, due to price increases enacted by Miami-Dade County to the City, the City was compelled to increase its utility billing to residents in Fiscal Year 2024-2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission adopted Resolution #2025-31 on May 1, 2025, providing for a four (4) percent reduction in the water consumption fee portion of the utility bill rate which was in effect in May for Fiscal Year 2025-2026; and

**WHEREAS**, upon further budget review, improvement in efficiency, and in an effort to provide greater financial relief to residents, the City Commission now desires to **increase** that reduction from four (4) percent to six (6) percent; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds it is in the best interest of the residents of the City of West Miami to repeal and supersede Resolution #2025-31 and authorize a new rate reduction as stated herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** Resolution #2025-31 is hereby repealed and superseded in its entirety.

**SECTION 3.** The City of West Miami hereby authorizes a six (6) percent reduction in the water consumption fee portion of the utility bill rate which was in effect on May 1, 2025 for all residential customers, effective for bills issued on or after October 1, 2025, as part of the City’s adopted budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026).

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
