



RESOLUTION # 2025-55

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA; RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION; APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF FOUR-WAY-STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF SW 63RD AVENUE AND SW 16TH STREET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(Sponsored by Administration)

WHEREAS, commission is committed to the safety of residents and guests of city roadways; and

WHEREAS, traffic incidents and resident input have indicated concerns regarding safety at the intersection of SW 63 Avenue and SW 16 Street in West Miami; and

WHEREAS, the installation of a four-way-stop may significantly improve traffic flow and pedestrian safety at this intersection; and

WHEREAS, a temporary demonstration project would allow for a thorough evaluation of the effectiveness of a four-way-stop at this intersection before making it permanent; and

WHEREAS, this demonstration results will be included and help develop projects to implement into the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) grant project titled West Miami Transportation Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami here by authorizes the City Manager to implement a demonstration project for a four-way stop at the intersection of SW 16 Street and SW 63 Avenue for a period of 3- months; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that during this demonstration period, the Responsible Department shall.

Section 1: Install temporary four-way stop signs and any necessary related markings and signage at the intersection of SW 16 Street and SW 63 Avenue.

Section 2: Monitor traffic patterns, vehicle speeds, and accident data at the intersection.

Section 3: Gather public feedback regarding the effectiveness of the four-way stop through surveys, public meetings or other appropriate means.

Section 4: Prepare a report summarizing the findings and recommendations regarding the future of the four-way stop at this intersection, including whether to make it permanent.

Section 5: The resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
