



RESOLUTION # 2025-57

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA; RELATING TO GRANTS; APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF RUBBERIZED SURFACE BELOW THE EXISTING AND NEWLY INSTALLED EXERCISE EQUIPMENT AREAS AT COOPER PARK FUNDED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED AND COMPLETE THE PROJECT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$40,000); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (*Sponsored by Administration*)

WHEREAS, the City of West Miami is committed to creating spaces where families can enjoy, children can benefit from a safe outdoor space and provide opportunities to improve overall wellness; and

WHEREAS, the City was successful in securing grant funding via Resolution No. 2024-07 entering into a contract with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to install exercise equipment at Cooper Park; and

WHEREAS, commission understands that to successfully complete and remain in compliance with the grant scope a rubberized surface must be installed; and

WHEREAS, commission approves the projects next phase to rubberize the said exercise areas not to exceed the cost of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

THE ABOVE WHEREAS' ARE ADOPTED HEREIN AS PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.

Section 1: The City Commission hereby approves the continuation and completion of the Exercise Equipment project of Cooper Park Related to FRDAP Grant #A24068 with the rubberizing of the grounds below said equipment.

Section 2: The City Commission hereby accepts the recommendation to move forward with the completion of the Cooper Park Exercise Equipment project with the installation of rubberized surface not to exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

Section 4: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter in contracts and negotiate in the City's best interest for the completion of the Cooper Park Exercise Equipment project with the purchase and installation of rubberized surface.

Section 4: The resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
