A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, ACCEPTING THE COST FOR THE NEW COMMUNITY PATHWAY “PASEO” LOCATED ON SW 65TH AVENUE AND 24TH STREET, TO INCLUDE THE DEMOLITION OF EXISTING SIDEWALK AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW PATHWAY IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FORTY-ONE DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$ 28,441.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. *(Sponsored by Administration)*

WHEREAS, In order to expand the beautification process of the City and invite residents to have more public outdoor spaces for their enjoyment, the City created a new pathway called “Paseo” this amenity will have art pieces, benches and other features for the enjoyment of the residents; and

WHEREAS, the City would like commission to acknowledge the costs that were entailed for the construction of this pathway to include \$ 28,441.00 for the old sidewalk removal and the installation of a bigger sidewalk in width with pavement feature; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2: The City Commission hereby accepts the costs associated for the implementation of the new pathway called “Paseo” for the enjoyment of its residents for the total cost of Twenty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred and Forty-One Dollars and Zero Cents (\$ 28,441.00).


Section 5: This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
