



RESOLUTION # 2025-78

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FROM MAGGOLC, INC. TO DO EMERGENCY SPOT DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS ON SW 10TH STREET WEST OF 59TH AVENUE, SW 11TH STREET BETWEEN 60TH COURT AND 59TH AVENUE, SW 11TH STREET AND 61ST AVENUE AND TRENCH DRAINING WITH RECOUNTOURING OF THE SWALE ON SW 12TH STREET EAST OF 62ND. AVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED- AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$ 125,000.00); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (*Sponsored by Administration*)

WHEREAS, during recent past with the heavy downpour of rain it has come to the City's attention that major emphasis is needed immediately to remedy the flooding issues targeted in the areas specified; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to remedy these issues and provide relief to its residents affected by this; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article IV, Section 2-74(b) provides that the Commission, by 4/5 vote, may authorize waving the requirement and procedure for waiver of purchasing; and

WHEREAS, the Administration finds the procurement requirements should be waived due to the urgency of this request and override the procurement process; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

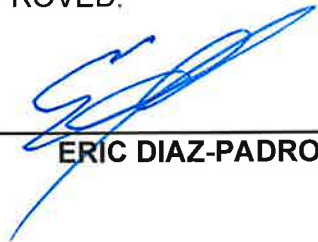
Section 2: The City Commission hereby accepts the recommendation of Administration to waive procurement requirements citing "urgency" of the City of West Miami Code of Ordinances.

Section 3: The City Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to accept the proposal of Maggolc, Inc. to repair targeted areas and improve drainage on its streets in the amount of One Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$ 125,000.00).

Section 5: This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
