



## RESOLUTION # 2025-79

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA; RELATING TO GRANTS, AUTHORIZING RETROACTIVELY, TO SEPTEMBER 22, 2025, THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE REQUIRED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI- DADE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI FOR THE PROVISION OF ON-DEMAND SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (*Sponsored by Administration*)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of West Miami wishes to enhance local mobility using nontraditional resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the City secured funding for the On-Demand service and Commission accepted the funding via Resolution 2024-103; and

**WHEREAS**, the City agreed to execute said ILA as a requirement of the funding and for the continued reimbursement of CITT funds for this service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to move forward with the signing of the Interlocal Agreement between Miami-Dade County for the ability to provide On-Demand services to help increase bus routes and transit for the existing Miami-Dade Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW).

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

**THE ABOVE WHEREAS' ARE ADOPTED HEREIN AS PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.**

**Section 1:** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption.

**Section 2:** The City Commission hereby authorizes retroactively, to September 22, 2025, the execution of said ILA, which benefits West Miami residents and guests.

**Section 3:** The resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


