



RESOLUTION # 2025-81

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF A JOINT USE AGREEMENT WITH THE MIAMI-DADE SCHOOL BOARD; PROVIDING THAT FENCES AND CAMERAS REQUIRED TO BE INSTALLED AT SYLVANIA HEIGHTS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO IMPLEMENT THE JOINT USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD AND THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI WILL BE INSTALLED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD, WHICH WILL BE REIMBURSED BY THE CITY PURSUANT TO THE JOINT USE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. *(Sponsored by Administration)*

WHEREAS, The Miami-Dade School Board and the City of West Miami have entered into a mutually-beneficial Joint Use Agreement (JUA) for the use by the City of certain portions of the fields of Sylvania Heights Elementary School, approved by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, The Joint Use Agreement provides that the City is responsible for installing certain fences and cameras to be installed on the Sylvania Heights School grounds; and

WHEREAS, The School Board has pre-existing product suppliers and installation capability which will accomplish the required fencing and cameras tasks in an efficient and less costly manner than if such work is undertaken by the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Commission of the City of West Miami as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing “whereas” clauses and heading are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of the Resolution provided herein.

Section 2: The City of West Miami agrees with the Miami-Dade School Board that the School Board shall acquire and install the fencing and cameras which are required by the Joint Use Agreement relating to Sylvania Heights Elementary School, and the City shall reimburse the School Board for the costs of doing so, not to exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




