



RESOLUTION # 2025-84

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WEST MIAMI, FLORIDA, FOLLOWING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE BRANDING BOARD; ADOPTING “CENTRAL BARK” AS THE RECOMMENDED NAME FOR THE NEW DOG PARK LOCATED AT SW 65TH AVENUE AND 12TH STREET; ACKNOWLEDGING ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS OF “WEST WOOF PARK,” “PAW PATCH PARK,” AND “HOUND HAVEN PARK”; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Branding Board has been tasked with evaluating and recommending a suitable name for the new dog park located at SW 65th Avenue and 12th Street; and

WHEREAS, the dog park will serve as an inviting recreational space designed to enhance community engagement and provide a safe, enjoyable environment for residents and their canine companions; and

WHEREAS, the name of the park is an important part of its identity, reflecting both the character of the community and the City’s commitment to family-friendly and pet-friendly spaces; and

WHEREAS, after thoughtful discussion and public input, the Branding Board has identified “**Central Bark**” as its primary recommended name, capturing a modern, playful, and community-focused spirit that aligns with the City of West Miami’s character; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the primary recommendation, the Branding Board proposes three alternative names for consideration: “**West Woof Park**”, emphasizing local identity; “**Paw Patch Park**”, reflecting energy and friendliness; and “**Hound Haven Park**”, symbolizing comfort and companionship;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of West Miami, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing “whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption thereof.

Section 2. The Branding Board of the City of West Miami hereby recommends “**Central Bark**” as the official name for the new dog park located at SW 65th Avenue and 12th Street.

Section 3. The Branding Board further presents “**West Woof Park**”, “**Paw Patch Park**”, and “**Hound Haven Park**” as alternative names for consideration by the City Commission.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor, City Commission, and other appropriate officials for review and adoption.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


